

Elisha Snipes to William Smith – Oct. 25, 1802

This indenture made this twenty fifth day of October, one thousand and eight hundred and two between Elisha Snipes of Darlington County of South Carolina of the one part and William Smith of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Elisha Snipes hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him paid by the said William Smith at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said confirmed and do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, enforce and assign fee simple unto the said William Smith his heirs – a certain tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the County of Northampton and bounded as follows to wit – beginning at a corner pine in Darling Drury’s line, thence along said Drury’s line to Cardale Dupree’s line, thence along the said Dupree’s line to John Hart’s corner line oak in the head of Pottecasay Swamp, thence down the said swamp to a corner Turkey Oak on the east side of said swamp, thence to the beginning containing seventy acres more or less, it being the said land granted by William Lewis unto the said Elisha Snipes by Deed of Gift. To have and to hold the said land with all the privileges appertaining thereunto, unto the said William Smith his heirs forever and duly acknowledge myself to be fully satisfied for the same and will * defend the right and title to all intents and purposes unto the said William Smith. In witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the day and date first above written.**
