Deed

This Indenture made this thirty fifth day of Oct:
One thousand Eight Hundred and two Between
Elisha Stripes of Darlington County of South
Carolina of the one part and William Smith of the County of South
Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth that the
County and State of North Carolina of the other part. Witnesseth that the
said Elisha Stripes hath for and in consideration of the sum of one hun-
dred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said W. Smith at and before
the sealing and delivering of this presents, the receipt whereof the said
Stripes both acknowledges both grants, bargains and sales, aliened, conveyed
and confirmed and so by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, convey and
confirm in full simple unto the said W. Smith his Heirs &c. a certain tract or
parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of South Carolina
and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a Corner place in Darlington
County line, thence along said Darlington line to Cora's old Dupuis line, thence
along the said Dupuis line to John Hart's Corner line back in the head of
Fittes's swamp, thence down the said swamp to a Corner marking Oak on the
west side of said swamp, thence to the Beginning, containing twenty acres
more or less, it being the said land granted by W. Smith unto the said Elisha
Stripes by Deed of Gift. It shall and to hold the said land with all the premises

appertaining thereto unto the said W. Smith his Heirs &c. forever and
I hereby acknowledge myself fully satisfied for the same and will ever defend the
right and title, to all intents and purposes unto the said W. Smith his Heirs &c.
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 30 day, and next first above
written.
