sealed with our Seals, and dated this *21st* day of *May* Anno Domini
1808

THE Condition of the above Obligation is such, that whereas the above bounden
George McDowell hath made application for a Licence for a Marriage to be
celebrated between him and *Sarah Doby* of the County aforesaid:
Now, in Case it shall not appear hereafter, that there is any lawful Cause or Impediment to
obstruct the said Marriage, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in
full Force and Virtue.
