 fifty Acres, more or less. To have and to hold, the above described Land  
 with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, unto the said Amy Wright  
 her heirs and assigns forever. And the said Micajah Hill for myself  
 my heirs &c. will warrant and defend the right and title of the said  
 Land unto the said Amy Wright her heirs &c. forever. - In Witness
