 This Indenture made the 11th day of May 1808
 Between Micaiah Hill & Amy Wright both of the County of
 Wake, & State of North Carolina Witnesseth that the S^r. Micaiah Hill for the
 sum of two hundred and fifty eight Dollars, to him in hand paid hath
 bargained, and sold, unto the said Amy Wright her heirs &c a certain
 tract of land, lying in the County & State afores^d. on the South side of New
 River, Beginning on the Mill Stone branch, at the mouth of a Spring
 branch, that runs from where said Wright formerly lived now belonging
 to William Binton, thence with said Hills line 170 pole to a Branch, called
 Riches Mill Branch, thence down the various Courses of the same, to the Mill
 Stone Branch, thence up the Mill Stone to the first station, Continuing South
 Amy to the same now or l^yp, to have and to have &c to hold, the above
 described land, with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said
 Amy Wright her heirs &c forever and the said Micaiah Hill
 will warrant, & defend the right and title of the said land, unto the
 said Amy Wright her heirs &c forever. In Witness whereof the said Micaiah
