Then my will & Desire is that after all my Just Debts are paid that my loving wife Mary Fulgam should have the use of all my Estate Real & personal during her life or widowhood to maintain & provide for my Children upon and at her death or marriage my will is that all my before mentioned Estate be equally divided between all my Children then & share alike

Lastly I do nominate and appoint Edmund Fulgam

and Mathew Tomberlon Ex<sup>ts</sup> of this my last  
will ratifying and conforming this to be my last  
will & Testament signed with my hand & sealed  
with my seal this fourth Day of October 1734
