

March the 15<sup>th</sup> 1823 the church being met  
According to appointment Commenced by praise  
and prayer inquired for the health of the church  
and found all in peace then set our doors open  
for church provided — we recd a letter from  
the Jesse settlement church requesting the Elders  
and Eldership of our church to set with them  
at their meeting in April Next

April the 19 1823 the Church being met as usual  
and worship commenced as usual Inquiry made for  
the health of the Church and found Sister  
McQueen under censure and left it as a reform  
Thereon invited to a set and after a warm exhortation  
recd a letter from Lick Creek Church for the Elders  
and Eldership as helps with them it was agreed on and  
appointed Br Riley Br Stephens and Br Kinney  
to set with them as helps in the ordination of a  
preacher

May the 17 1823 the Church being met  
as usual and after sermon was delivered the church  
took up the Reform between Br Doolyget and Sister  
McQueen and agreed to leave it to a committee  
who declared on non-fellowship with Sister McQueen  
then the Clerk was appointed to write to Liberty  
Church in Wake County for the fellowship of Stouge,  
Bill wife of Lion Hill

July the 19 1823 the Church being met  
as usual and inquiry made for the health  
of the Church and found all well and our doors  
were opened as usual and Sister delany and cander  
Bill came forward with a letter of fellowship  
from Liberty Church Wake County and was  
recd with us as a member in full fellowship
