Will of Anne Exum - 1792

In the name of God amen, I Anne Exum dispose of my worldly estate as follows...

1st – I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Dancy one bed and furniture, one bay mair (mare) with a blasé (?) on her face to her and her heirs forever

 2^{nd} – I give and bequeath unto my son James Exum the remainder of my estate of every sort kind or denomination whatsoever to him and his heirs forever – and I do hereby nominate and appoint my son James Exum whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament – in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 3^{rd} day of January 1792
