Item My Will & Desire is that my Stud Horse &
the Horse I had of Robert Jones should be sold
& if any Money arising from thence after paying
my just Debts, that to be Equally divided between
the above mentioned Legates —

to My Desire is that if my Daughter dies before she
come to the Age of Twenty One Years or Marries, that
her proportionable part of the above Estate should
descend to my Wife Charlotte Eason —
